Recommendation of Research Scheme for Field Veterinarian/Farmers

The most recognizable indexive and early sign of fluorosis recorded was dental fluorosis being the highest in Mehsana district followed by Patan and Banaskantha Districts. Veterinarian as such should specifically look to such teeth lesion so as to advise to farmers to prevent further progress to fluorosis by giving good quality/defluorinated water.
